**Board of Trustees Updates:** *A Board of Trustees building project site meeting was held this morning, with Mcllwaine's Building from Marton. The actual building starts next Monday, 16 April, with de-constructing the old boiler room. This is in preparation for building a new junior toilet block, which will be accessed from the Room One end of the front veranda. The back part of the old boiler room will be developed into a 'breakout' space for the use of room one teachers and students, connected to the classroom by a clear sliding door. Further building improvements will continue in and around rooms one, two and three and the connecting hall wall, right through term two until the end of term two holidays, July 21 2018. We are hopeful that this first stage of our five year building upgrade will be completed by then!*

**Important Safety Warning:** **During the first week of the holidays – Monday 16 to Thursday 19 April, the school entrances, classrooms, hall and all asphalt and play areas are CLOSED to all children, families and whanau... This is to allow the safe removal of asbestos from inside the boiler room with decontamination and cleaning completed before further building work starts in week two of the holidays.**
